Pathway into Adulthood and who can help

<u>Age 16-17 years</u>	Adult Social Services receive early notification forms from Cheviots and Waverley School on students who are approaching 18 years old.
<u>Age 17 (nearing 18th Birthday)</u>	Adult Social Services will allocate a new social worker to your child. They will make contact with you and start the Moving on Process.
<u>Age 17 - 18</u>	Parents You need to start thinking about the provision you would like for your child. Please arrange visits to the Day Centres and College to see what options are available. Do you want your child to have some sort of job in the future - Enfield Careers may be able to support you. Also Enfield Equals Employment Services could assist with any requests. After school clubs - do you want your child to attend a club or have holiday provision as Cheviots finishes at 18. Speak to your Social Worker

<p><u>Age 18 - 19</u></p>	<p>Final Year of School: Autumn Term EHCP review at Waverley in October or November for your child. Adult Social Worker will attend meeting. Discussions take place on your child's future. Pathway finalised and applications made to Barnet and Southgate College or Referrals made to Day Centres. Travel forms completed for College. After school clubs will start for students 18 years plus.</p>
<p><u>Age 18-19</u></p>	<p>Spring Term January to March Confirmation of your child's placement at College or Day Centre. Meeting with Gary at Waverley and Adult Social Worker (if needed) to discuss final details.</p>
<p><u>Age 18-19</u></p>	<p>Summer Term Transition visits will happen for all leavers. They will have regular supported visits to their chosen Day Centre or College. End of Year 'Leavers Evening Celebration' and 'Leavers Day' both held at Waverley. (July) Leavers Residential to High Ashurst in Surrey. Students and staff go away for a 3 day / 2 night residential to an Outdoor Activity Centre</p>
